Job purpose

The Road Home and Wasatch Homeless Health Care, Inc. (dba. Fourth Street Clinic) are seeking a Registered Nurse (RN) with psychiatric experience. This position offers the applicant the opportunity to work with a diverse patient population in a variety of settings, to enjoy a broad and dynamic professional role, and to work with a collaborative interdisciplinary team for support.

Background

The Road Home is the primary homeless shelter for adults and families in Salt Lake City. In collaboration with the Road Home and Fourth Street Clinic, this position will be part of the Road Home Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) (grant-funded); which is a collaborative team of case managers and behavioral health (BH) clinicians who staff a modified Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) team. This team provides comprehensive BH services to recently homeless clients, with services often taking place in clients' homes, on the street, or on-site at the office of one of many collaborating service providers. The HSSP team includes employees of the Road Home, Volunteers of America, and the Fourth Street Clinic. The RN assigned to work with this interdisciplinary team has the opportunity to form relationships with severely ill clients with mental health and substance use disorders, , provide health education and nursing assessments, and participate in a variety of advocacy and case-management duties in collaboration with other members of the team. The RN may join other team members to see patients in the hospital, visit them while incarcerated, and search for them in the community when needed.

Duties and responsibilities



- Deliver and assist with the management and administration of medication, as indicated by psychiatric evaluation conducted by the APRN, in an appropriate and safe manner to provide quality care, following accepted clinical methods and techniques.
- Work with APRN to ensure continuity of care for clients.
- Assist in the implementation of each patient's plan for treatment in order to provide quality care by utilizing accepted clinical methods and techniques, acting collaboratively with another licensed practitioner.
- Assists with weekly medication clinics.
- Conduct in-home assessments of patients' environment, including basic hygiene, nutrition and physical safety level.
- Make follow up appointments on behalf of patients at 4th Street Clinic and assist with care coordination on behalf of patients with other health care providers.
- Liaise with outside medical professionals in cases of client hospitalization.
- Provide health and mental health education to patients.
- Educate team members about patients' medication needs.
- Support the work of the HSSP team through care coordination.
- Support the core program as directed by supervisor.
- Transportation of patients in an agency vehicle may be required.
- Perform safety assessments to include risk of harm to self or others, and work with the client and other team members to construct and implement safety plans.

Qualifications

- Graduated from an accredited college or university.
- Active RN License in the state of Utah.
- Knowledge of the theory and techniques of crisis intervention, trauma-informed care, and general psychological principles and concepts.
- Supports and encourages a collaborative culture that values mutual respect, partnership, learning, trust, and fairness.
- Models positive and appropriate professional behavior.
- Proactive in behavior and fosters that in others.
- Basic Life Support (BLS) certification

Experience

- Experience with populations that have behavioral health disorders.
- Experience with underserved populations preferred
