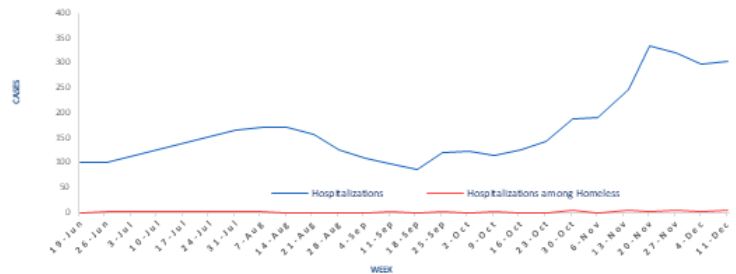

DATA DOWNLOAD

- We have had a total of 1,708 guests stay at our Q&I facilities.
- Total number of guests currently in our Q&I facility is 61.
- Total hospitalizations 3,354 with 81 (2.4%) individuals experiencing homelessness
- Current hospitalizations 304 with 4 (1.3%) individuals experiencing homelessness

GENERAL UPDATES

- The VP Shower Program is still running at three SLCO recreation centers. In the month of November, 222 showers were utilized! The shower program locations and hours are outlined in the adjacent table.

- As of 12/16/2020, there are 72 individuals who have transitioned out of the *Stay Home, Stay Safe* VP Hotel Program, and into housing. This is over a third of the total people that have exited the VP Hotel program! Thank you to all partners that play parts in getting each individual eligible for long-term housing options.
